

Special Meeting
November 12, 2015

The Towns of Stantonsburg, Black Creek, Lucama and Sharpsburg met at 7:00 pm at the Black Creek Community Center to hear the recommendations by Kevin O'Donnell of Nova Energy Consultants for a power supplier.

The following members from Stantonsburg Town Council were present: Mayor Bill Edmundson, Councilmen Powell Dew, Jr., Donnie Bass, Ken Horne and Councilwoman Jackie Grice. Councilman Robert Watson was absent due to a prior obligation. Also present were Town Manager Gary Davis and Town Clerk Debra Beamon.

At this time the Black Creek, Lucama and Sharpsburg voted to go into closed session. Councilman Dew made a motion to go into closed session. Councilwoman Grice seconded the motion with all other members present voting in favor of the motion.

Black Creek, Lucama and Sharpsburg voted to go back into open session at this time. Councilman Dew made a motion to go back into open session. Councilman Horne seconded the motion with all other Council members voting in favor of the motion.

Kevin O'Donnell recommended NTE as the new power supplier for the (4) Towns when the contract expires with Duke Progress beginning January 1, 2018. The (4) Towns voted individually.

The Town of Black Creek voted unanimously to accept the contract with NTE.

The Town of Lucama voted unanimously to accept the contract with NTE.

The Town of Sharpsburg voted unanimously to accept the contract with NTE.

At this time, Councilman Dew made a motion to accept the contract with NTE beginning January 1, 2018. Councilman Bass seconded the motion. All other members present voted in favor of the motion.

The Towns each individually voted to adjourn. Councilman Dew made a motion for the Stantonsburg Town Council to adjourn, with a second from Councilman Horne. All members voted favorably.

The meeting adjourned at 8:08 pm.
